

The **2015-2017** State's Biennial Budget Bill (2015 Wisconsin Act 55) made numerous changes to laws that affect Wisconsin Public School Districts. School Districts are required to provide notice to parents of the school board's adopted educational standards prior to the beginning of the school year. This notice obligation imposed by the new statute may be satisfied by posting a link to the Board adopted standards on the District's website.

For purposes of satisfying these notice obligations, the following North Crawford School Board policies all cover different aspects of the **District's academic standards**:

A provision in the statute has also been added to require that school boards place a notice on the agenda of the Board's first meeting of each school year that "clearly identifies the pupil academic standards adopted by the school board under s. 118.30(1g)(a)1 that will be in effect for the school year."

- Act 55 requires school boards to provide the public with a description of the **educational opportunities** available within the district.
- Wis. Stat. § 118.57 requires school districts to annually publish, prior to January 31, a description of the educational options available to the child, including public schools, private schools participating in a parental choice program, charter schools, virtual schools, full-time open enrollment, youth options, and course options.
- The description must be published as a Class 1 notice under Chapter 985 of the state statutes, which requires one (1) insertion of the description in the official newspaper of the school district.
