

## **2018-2019 Lenz Family Endowment Scholarship** **Criteria/Instructions**

*Please read carefully the eligibility criteria and follow all instructions.*

### **Scholarship Details:**

Established by Fred Lenz, the Lenz Family Endowment Scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior from each of the 30 high schools in Southwest Tech's district. Fred Lenz graduated from Fennimore High School in 1939. When asked why he choose the Southwest Tech Foundation as the recipient of his gift, Mr. Lenz stated, "From the time I was very young, my mother, who had been a teacher, kept telling me that education was the gateway to a better life. Then, during my working life, I kept meeting people all over the world who had a great deal to offer their societies, but had never had the opportunity to develop their potential and skills—skills that could have helped them support their families better and contributed more to their communities and societies. This scholarship endowment will provide that opportunity to hundreds, and over time perhaps thousands, of southwest Wisconsin residents."

(\$1,000 Scholarship given to each of the 30 Southwest Tech district high schools.)

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Student must be a senior in high school to apply.
- Student and parent(s) must be U.S. citizens.
- Family of recipient must have resided in the state of Wisconsin for five (5) years.
- Recipient must have attended the last three (3) years in the school district from which he/she is receiving the scholarship.
- Student must rank in the lower 70 percentile of his/her graduating class.
- Students must enroll full-time (12 or more credits) in a **one or two-year program** at Southwest Tech the fall semester after high school graduation.
- Funds will be released in two installments: one-half during the first semester and the remainder of the scholarship during the second semester, if a minimum of a 2.5 GPA is maintained the first semester and student is enrolled full-time.

### **Application Instructions:**

- The student must complete all sections of the application.
- Return completed application to your high school counselor.
- High school counselor must insert class ranking at the end of the first semester of the student's senior year and sign in space provided.

### **Application Dates:**

- Lenz Family Endowment Scholarship applications must be submitted by the student to the high school guidance counselor on **March 30, 2017**.
- **April 6, 2017**, recipient's name and the name of the alternates will be entered on the Recipient Selection Form and emailed to **Gina Udelhofen** at [gudelhofen@swtc.edu](mailto:gudelhofen@swtc.edu) at Southwest Tech Foundation by the High School Counselor.
- Recipient will be notified the week of April 23 of their award and announced at the scholarship ceremony.
